

Arrests by Offense Category

This year 56.4 percent of all Part II arrests were made in just four offense categories. These offenses were Disorderly Conduct, 56,069 or 16.4 percent, with an arrest rate of 456.3; All Other Offenses (Except Traffic), 50,077 or 14.7 percent, with an arrest rate of 407.6; Other Assaults - Not Aggravated, 45,442 or 13.3 percent, with an arrest rate of 369.8; and Driving Under the Influence, 41,284 or 12.1 percent, with an arrest rate of 336.0.

Arrests by Age

The distribution of Part II arrests by broad age categories was as follows: juveniles (under 18 years of age), 58,536 or 17.1 percent; young adults (under 25 years of age), 115,591 or 33.8 percent; and adults (persons 25 or older), 167,612, or 49.0 percent.

Juvenile arrests decreased .8 percent from last year's total of 59,001, while young adult arrests increased 3.3 percent from last year's total of 111,934 and arrests of adults decreased .3 percent from last year's total of 168,170.

Juveniles accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following offenses:

- Vandalism (39.8 percent)
- Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (31.4 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (28.8 percent)
- Liquor Law (27.9 percent)

Young adults (under 25) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following offenses:

- Liquor Law (68.0 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (48.4 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (46.9 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Synthetic (44.2 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Other (42.2 percent)

Adults (25 or older) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following offenses:

- Gambling - Book Making (100.0 percent)
- Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (93.3 percent)
- Prostitution and Commercialized Vice (83.0 percent)

Drug Possession - Opium - Cocaine (73.5 percent)
Driving Under the Influence (71.4 percent)
Gambling - Other (69.8 percent)
Fraud (67.7 percent)
Offenses Against Family & Children (65.2 percent)

Forgery and Counterfeiting (63.4 percent)

The majority of juvenile arrests were made for the following offenses:

Disorderly Conduct (27.6 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.9 percent)
Liquor Law (14.8 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (13.9 percent)

The majority of young adult arrests were made for the following offenses:

Liquor Law (18.2 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (16.1 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (13.1 percent)

The majority of adult arrests were made for the following offenses:

Driving Under the Influence (17.6 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (16.0 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (15.4 percent)

Arrests by Sex

This year 266,705 or 78.0 percent of the persons arrested were male, a decrease of .2 percent from last year's total of 267,114. Female arrests totaled 75,034, a 4.2 increase from last year's total of 71,991.

The majority of male arrests were made for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (15.7 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.8 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.1 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (12.7 percent)

The majority of female arrests were made for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (18.8 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.2 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.8 percent)
- Liquor Law (11.2 percent)

Arrests by Race

This year 259,834 or 76.0 percent of the persons arrested were White, 79,921 or 23.4 percent were Black, and 1,984 or .6 percent were Other Races.

Arrests of Whites increased 1.1 percent from last year's total of 257,112, while arrests of Blacks decreased .1 percent from last year's 80,010. Arrests of Other Races increased .1 percent from last year's total of 1,983.

Whites comprised the majority of persons arrested for most Part II Offenses, ranging from 100.0 percent of Gambling - Book Making to 53.1 percent for Drug Possession - Opium - Cocaine. Blacks comprised the majority of persons arrested for Drug Sale/Mfg - Opium - Cocaine (63.1); Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (61.7); Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (59.5) and Prostitution and Commercialized Vice (56.5).

The majority of Whites were arrested for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (16.6 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.4 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.2 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (12.6 percent)
- Liquor Law (11.2 percent)

The majority of Blacks were arrested for the following offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (16.0 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (15.6 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (15.6 percent)
Drug Sale/Mfg - Opium - Cocaine (10.4 percent)
Drug Possession - Opium - Cocaine (6.7 percent)

The majority of Other Races were arrested for the following offenses:

Disorderly Conduct (16.0 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.8 percent)
Liquor Law (12.8 percent)
Driving Under the Influence (12.2 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (9.9 percent)
