

During 2004, the Pennsylvania Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program received data for 1,056 jurisdictions. Contributions to the Program may range from the submission of data for one month to the submission of data for the entire year. Contributing jurisdictions and the corresponding number of submissions are identified in the following link.

Pennsylvania law enforcement agencies are not required to submit data to the Uniform Crime Reporting Program; however, on November 29, 2004, Governor Edward G Rendell signed into law Senate Bill 668. This law, effective June 1, 2005, mandates reporting for all state, county, and local law enforcement agencies within the Commonwealth. Individual agencies may have submitted data for multiple jurisdictions. Information contained in this complete report is based on actual data submitted as of the date of compilation. Analysis is based on data that may have been updated after release of proceeding years' reports.
