

Value of Property Stolen and Recovered

The total value of property stolen in Pennsylvania in 2009 was \$418,086,945, of which 24.6 percent or \$102,645,716 was recovered. The total value decreased by 10.4 percent from \$466,694,265 the previous year, and total recovered property decreased by 13.2 percent. Locally stolen motor vehicles accounted for 37.5 percent of stolen property value and 80.8 percent of property recovered in 2009.
