

Analysis of Property Damaged

The total property damage due to arson in 2009 was \$83,771,287, a 44.0 percent increase from the \$58,157,690 in property damage reported the previous year. The average value of property damaged during an arson in 2009 was \$38,837, a 58.8 percent increase from the \$24,457 average the previous year.

As outlined in the previous table, 1,214 or 56.3 percent of arsons involved structures, 22.4 percent or 483 involved mobile property, and 21.3 percent or 460 involved other arsons, such as crops, timber, etc. Of the 1,214 structure arsons, 233 or 19.2 percent involved uninhabited buildings or structures not in normal use.
