

Value of Property Stolen and Recovered

The total value of property stolen in Pennsylvania in 2010 was \$391,943,464, of which 15.2 percent or \$59,399,474 was recovered. The total value decreased by 6.4 percent from \$418,804,173 the previous year, and total recovered property decreased by 42.2 percent. Locally stolen motor vehicles accounted for 35.4 percent of stolen property value and 73.2 percent of property recovered in 2010.
