

## **Analysis of Property Stolen**

As outlined in the previous tables, \$150,106,626 in property was stolen in the 202,522 larceny-thefts reported in 2010, with an average value per larceny-theft of \$741. This is a decrease of 2.2 percent from the \$153,463,841 in property stolen in larceny-thefts the previous year. Thefts from buildings (except shoplifting and from any coin operated machines) showed the largest percentage increase in total dollars stolen, at 5.5 percent.
