

## **Arrests by Offense Category**

In 2010, 60.1 percent of all Part II arrests were made in just four offense categories. These offenses were Disorderly Conduct, 59,879 or 16.6 percent, with an arrest rate of 471.4; All Other Offenses (Except Traffic), 54,851 or 15.3 percent, with an arrest rate of 431.8; Driving Under the Influence, 52,403 or 14.6 percent, with an arrest rate of 412.5; and Other Assaults - Not Aggravated, 49,116 or 13.7 percent, with an arrest rate of 386.7.

## **Arrests by Age**

The distribution of Part II arrests by broad age categories was as follows: juveniles (under 18 years of age), 47,901 or 13.3 percent; young adults (under 25 years of age), 117,595 or 32.7 percent; and adults (persons 25 or older), 194,150 or 54.0 percent.

Juvenile Part II arrests decreased 5.0 percent from the previous year's total of 50,406, while young adult Part II arrests decreased 2.5 percent from the previous year's total of 120,644, and Part II arrests of adults increased 1.2 percent from the previous year's total of 191,892.

Juveniles accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Vandalism (30.9 percent)
- Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (29.1 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (25.4 percent)
- Liquor Law (24.4 percent)

Young adults (under 25) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Liquor Law (72.3 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (49.1 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (45.7 percent)
- Stolen Prop., Rec., Posses., Buying (39.8 percent)
- Gambling - Book Making (38.5 percent)

Adults (25 or older) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (88.5 percent)
- Prostitution and Commercialized Vice (81.8 percent)
- Fraud (74.7 percent)

Disorderly Conduct (31.8 percent)  
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (16.6 percent)  
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (13.4 percent)  
Liquor Law (12.8 percent)

The majority of young adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

Disorderly Conduct (16.0 percent)  
Liquor Law (15.4 percent)  
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (12.8 percent)

The majority of adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

Driving Under the Influence (19.8 percent)  
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (17.2 percent)  
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (15.0 percent)

## **Arrests by Sex**

In 2010, 271,926 or 75.6 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were male, a decrease of 1.7 percent from the previous year's total of 276,655. Female arrests totaled 87,720, a 1.7 increase from the previous year's total of 86,287.

The majority of male Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.7 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (15.4 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.7 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.3 percent)

The majority of female Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (20.6 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.8 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.0 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (13.9 percent)

## **Arrests by Race**

In 2010, 259,159 or 72.1 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were White, 98,040 or 27.3 percent were Black, and 2,409 or .7 percent were Other Races.

Part II arrests of Whites decreased 2.8 percent from the previous year's total of 266,729, while Part II arrests of Blacks increased 4.3 percent from the previous year's total of 94,027. Part II arrests of Other Races increased 12.0 percent from the previous year's total of 2,151.

Whites comprised the majority of persons arrested for most Part II offenses, ranging from 90.5 percent of Liquor Law violations to 54.9 percent for Drug Possession - Opium - Cocaine. Blacks comprised the majority of persons arrested for Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (92.3 percent); Vagrancy (71.8 percent); Weapons, Carrying, Possess, Etc. (58.4 percent); Drug Sale/Mfg - Opium - Cocaine (54.5 percent); and Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (51.4 percent).

The majority of Whites were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (17.3 percent)

Disorderly Conduct (16.2 percent)  
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.1 percent)  
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.5 percent)  
Liquor Law (8.7 percent)

The majority of Blacks were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (18.2 percent)  
Disorderly Conduct (17.8 percent)  
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.2 percent)  
Drug Possession - Marijuana (8.8 percent)  
Driving Under the Influence (7.2 percent)

The majority of Other Races were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

Driving Under the Influence (20.3 percent)  
Disorderly Conduct (15.5 percent)  
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.5 percent)  
Liquor Law (9.5 percent)  
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (8.8 percent)
