

Summary

Information contained in this chapter is derived from Supplemental Homicide Reports. Variations may occur between this chapter and the remainder of the report due to reporting adjustments made by contributing agencies.

There were 657 murder offenses reported to Pennsylvania police agencies in 2010, an average of 2 each day, or one every 13 hours and 20 minutes. This is an increase of .9 percent from the 651 murder offenses reported the previous year. Murder comprised .2 percent of the Crime Index and 1.4 percent of the Violent Crime Index. The murder rate was 5.2 per 100,000 population.
