

Summary

There were 16,314 robbery offenses reported to Pennsylvania police agencies in 2010, an average of 45 each day, or one every 32 minutes and 13 seconds. This is a decrease of 6.6 percent from the 17,470 offenses reported the previous year. Robbery comprised 5.1 percent of the Crime Index and 35.2 percent of the Violent Crime Index. The robbery rate was 128.4 per 100,000 population.
