

Summary

There were 54,845 burglary offenses reported to Pennsylvania police agencies in 2010, an average of 150 each day, or one every 9 minutes and 35 seconds. This is an increase of .5 percent from the 54,589 offenses reported the previous year. Burglary comprised 17.0 percent of the Crime Index and 19.9 percent of the Property Crime Index. The burglary rate was 431.8 per 100,000 population.
