

Analysis of Property Stolen

As outlined in the previous tables, \$170,927,807 in property was stolen in the 207,398 larceny-thefts reported in 2011, with an average value per larceny-theft of \$824. This is an increase of 13.6 percent from the \$150,522,143 in property stolen in larceny-thefts the previous year. Motor Vehicle Parts and Accessories showed the largest percentage increase in total dollars stolen, at 35.4 percent.
