

Arrests by Offense Category

In 2011, 59.7 percent of all Part II arrests were made in just four offense categories. These offenses were All Other Offenses (Except Traffic), 54,055 or 15.6 percent, with an arrest rate of 424.2; Disorderly Conduct, 53,228 or 15.4 percent, with an arrest rate of 417.7; Driving Under the Influence, 51,716 or 15.0 percent, with an arrest rate of 405.8; and Other Assaults - Not Aggravated, 47,159 or 13.6 percent, with an arrest rate of 370.1.

Arrests by Age

The distribution of Part II arrests by broad age categories was as follows: juveniles (under 18 years of age), 43,216 or 12.5 percent; young adults (under 25 years of age), 111,501 or 32.3 percent; and adults (persons 25 or older), 190,846 or 55.2 percent.

Juvenile Part II arrests decreased 9.9 percent from the previous year's total of 47,981, while young adult Part II arrests decreased 5.3 percent from the previous year's total of 117,784, and Part II arrests of adults decreased 1.8 percent from the previous year's total of 194,424.

Juveniles accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Vandalism (29.7 percent)
- Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (28.9 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (24.9 percent)
- Liquor Law (23.6 percent)

Young adults (under 25) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Liquor Law (73.3 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (48.8 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (45.4 percent)
- Stolen Prop., Rec., Posses., Buying (38.8 percent)
- Drug Possession - Other (36.0 percent)

Adults (25 or older) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Gambling - Book Making (100.0 percent)
- Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (100.0 percent)
- Prostitution and Commercialized Vice (84.1 percent)

The majority of young adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

Disorderly Conduct (14.5 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (13.0 percent)

The majority of adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

Driving Under the Influence (19.7 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (17.6 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (15.0 percent)

Arrests by Sex

In 2011, 260,251 or 75.3 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were male, a decrease of 4.4 percent from the previous year's total of 272,352. Female arrests totaled 85,312, a 2.9 decrease from the previous year's total of 87,837.

The majority of male Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (16.1 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (15.1 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (14.3 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.2 percent)

The majority of female Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (18.8 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.9 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.6 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.1 percent)

Arrests by Race

In 2011, 249,139 or 72.1 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were White, 93,765 or 27.1 percent were Black, and 2,623 or .8 percent were Other Races.

Part II arrests of Whites decreased 4.0 percent from the previous year's total of 259,641, while Part II arrests of Blacks decreased 4.4 percent from the previous year's total of 98,095. Part II arrests of Other Races increased 8.7 percent from the previous year's total of 2,412.

Whites comprised the majority of persons arrested for most Part II offenses, ranging from 100.0 percent of Gambling - Book Making violations to 53.4 percent for Prostitution and Commercialized Vice. Blacks comprised the majority of persons arrested for Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (93.1 percent); Vagrancy (61.0 percent); Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (58.8 percent); Drug Sale/Mfg - Opium - Cocaine (53.3 percent); and Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (50.5 percent).

The majority of Whites were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (17.7 percent)

Disorderly Conduct (15.2 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.2 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.4 percent)
Drunkenness (8.5 percent)

The majority of Blacks were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (19.4 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (16.1 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.3 percent)
Drug Possession - Marijuana (8.5 percent)
Driving Under the Influence (7.5 percent)

The majority of Other Races were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

Driving Under the Influence (20.4 percent)
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (16.8 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (12.5 percent)
Liquor Law (9.9 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (8.5 percent)
