

Summary

There were 207,398 larceny-theft offenses reported to Pennsylvania police agencies in 2011, an average of 568 each day, or 1 every 2 minutes and 32 seconds. This is an increase of 2.2 percent from the 202,978 offenses reported the previous year. Larceny-theft comprised 62.9 percent of the Crime Index and 73.1 percent of the Property Crime Index. The larceny-theft rate was 1,627.6 per 100,000 population.
