

Value of Property Stolen and Recovered

The total value of property stolen in Pennsylvania in 2012 was \$430,370,007, of which 19.3 percent or \$83,225,771 was recovered. The total value increased by .1 percent from \$429,911,661 the previous year, and total recovered property increased by 42.8 percent. Locally stolen motor vehicles accounted for 30.8 percent of stolen property value and 70.7 percent of property recovered in 2012.
