

## **Arrests by Offense Category**

In 2012, 59.8 percent of all Part II arrests were made in just four offense categories. These offenses were All Other Offenses (Except Traffic), 58,028 or 16.8 percent, with an arrest rate of 454.6; Disorderly Conduct, 51,031 or 14.8 percent, with an arrest rate of 399.8; Driving Under the Influence, 50,799 or 14.7 percent, with an arrest rate of 398.0; and Other Assaults - Not Aggravated, 46,208 or 13.4 percent, with an arrest rate of 362.0. The noted arrest rates are per 100,000 population.

## **Arrests by Age**

The distribution of Part II arrests by broad age categories was as follows: juveniles (under 18 years of age), 38,757 or 11.2 percent; young adults age 18 to 24, 108,361 or 31.4 percent; and adults (persons 25 or older), 197,605 or 57.3 percent.

Juvenile Part II arrests decreased 10.5 percent from the previous year's total of 43,295, while young adult Part II arrests decreased 3.0 percent from the previous year's total of 111,744, and Part II arrests of adults increased 3.3 percent from the previous year's total of 191,333.

Juveniles accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Vandalism (27.9 percent)
- Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (26.6 percent)
- Liquor Law (24.6 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (22.1 percent)

Young adults age 18 to 24 accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Liquor Law (70.0 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (49.1 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (44.5 percent)
- Stolen Prop., Rec., Posses., Buying (38.1 percent)
- Forgery and Counterfeiting (37.0 percent)

Adults (25 or older) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (97.1 percent)
- Prostitution and Commercialized Vice (84.2 percent)
- Gambling - Other (79.7 percent)

The majority of young adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

Disorderly Conduct (14.4 percent)  
Liquor Law (13.6 percent)  
All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (13.5 percent)

The majority of adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (19.4 percent)  
Driving Under the Influence (18.8 percent)  
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.5 percent)

## **Arrests by Sex**

In 2012, 259,662 or 75.3 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were male, a decrease of .5 percent from the previous year's total of 260,867. Female arrests totaled 85,061, a .5 decrease from the previous year's total of 85,505.

The majority of male Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (17.4 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.8 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (13.7 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (12.9 percent)

The majority of female Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (18.2 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.2 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (15.0 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.6 percent)

## **Arrests by Race**

In 2012, 248,183 or 72.0 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were White, 93,993 or 27.3 percent were Black, and 2,523 or .7 percent were Other Races.

Part II arrests of Whites decreased .7 percent from the previous year's total of 249,828, while Part II arrests of Blacks increased .1 percent from the previous year's total of 93,879. Part II arrests of Other Races decreased 4.0 percent from the previous year's total of 2,629.

The majority of Whites were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (17.4 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.0 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (14.5 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.3 percent)
- Drunkenness (8.6 percent)

The majority of Blacks were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (21.6 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (15.8 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.8 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (8.4 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (7.6 percent)

The majority of Other Races were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (19.3 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (17.7 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (12.0 percent)
- Liquor Law (11.1 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (8.7 percent)
