

Summary

There were 15,732 robbery offenses reported by Pennsylvania police agencies in 2012, an average of 43 each day, or one every 33 minutes and 25 seconds. This is a decrease of 2.5 percent from the 16,131 offenses reported the previous year. Robbery offenses comprised 4.9 percent of the Crime Index and 34.7 percent of the Violent Crime Index. The robbery rate was 123.3 per 100,000 population.
