

Arrests by Offense Category

In 2013, 59.9 percent of all Part II arrests were made in just four offense categories. These offenses were All Other Offenses (Except Traffic), 59,205 or 17.7 percent, with an arrest rate of 463.5; Driving Under the Influence, 48,197 or 14.4 percent, with an arrest rate of 377.3; Disorderly Conduct, 47,407 or 14.2 percent, with an arrest rate of 371.1; and Other Assaults - Not Aggravated, 45,387 or 13.6 percent, with an arrest rate of 355.3. The noted arrest rates are per 100,000 population. Although "Curfew and Loitering Laws (Under 18)" and "Runaways" are included in the calculations of Part II totals in the tables, they are not included in the calculations of the following summary information.

Arrests by Age

The distribution of Part II arrests by broad age categories was as follows: juveniles (under 18 years of age), 35,419 or 10.6 percent; young adults (18 - 24 years of age), 100,139 or 30.0 percent; and adults (persons 25 or older), 198,471 or 59.4 percent.

Juvenile Part II arrests decreased 8.7 percent from the previous year's total of 38,779, while young adult Part II arrests decreased 7.6 percent from the previous year's total of 108,406, and Part II arrests of adults increased .4 percent from the previous year's total of 197,693.

Juveniles accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Weapons, Carrying, Posses, Etc. (28.0 percent)
- Vandalism (27.6 percent)
- Liquor Law (22.8 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (22.4 percent)

Young adults (under 25) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Liquor Law (72.7 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (48.2 percent)
- Drug Sale/Mfg - Marijuana (43.3 percent)
- Stolen Prop., Rec., Posses., Buying (35.1 percent)
- Forgery and Counterfeiting (35.0 percent)

Adults (25 or older) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Gambling - Book Making (100.0 percent)
- Gambling - Numbers, Etc. (100.0 percent)

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.2 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (13.6 percent)
Liquor Law (13.0 percent)

The majority of adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (20.3 percent)
Driving Under the Influence (18.2 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.4 percent)

Arrests by Sex

In 2013, 251,452 or 75.3 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were male, a decrease of 3.2 percent from the previous year's total of 259,785. Female arrests totaled 82,577, a 3.0 decrease from the previous year's total of 85,093.

The majority of male Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (18.4 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.4 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.1 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (13.1 percent)

The majority of female Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- Disorderly Conduct (17.6 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.6 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (15.1 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.5 percent)

Arrests by Race

In 2013, 236,517 or 70.8 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were White, 94,758 or 28.4 percent were Black, and 2,736 or .8 percent were Other Races.

Part II arrests of Whites decreased 4.8 percent from the previous year's total of 248,330, while Part II arrests of Blacks increased .8 percent from the previous year's total of 94,001. Part II arrests of Other Races increased 8.4 percent from the previous year's total of 2,523.

The majority of Whites were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (17.3 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.3 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (13.9 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.6 percent)
- Drunkenness (8.5 percent)

The majority of Blacks were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (23.8 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (15.0 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.7 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (8.8 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (7.2 percent)

The majority of Other Races were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (18.6 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (18.4 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (11.1 percent)
- Liquor Law (10.2 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (8.3 percent)
