

Summary

There were 14,716 robbery offenses reported by Pennsylvania police agencies in 2013, an average of 40 each day, or one every 35 minutes and 43 seconds. This is a decrease of 6.5 percent from the 15,732 offenses reported the previous year. Robbery offenses comprised 4.8 percent of the Crime Index and 34.4 percent of the Violent Crime Index. The robbery rate was 115.2 per 100,000 population.
