

Summary

There were 23,646 aggravated assault offenses reported by Pennsylvania police agencies in 2013, an average of 65 each day, or one every 22 minutes and 14 seconds. This is a decrease of 7.6 percent from the 25,600 offenses reported the previous year. Aggravated assault offenses comprised 7.7 percent of the Crime Index and 55.3 percent of the Violent Crime Index. The aggravated assault rate was 185.1 per 100,000 population.
