

Summary

There were 196,877 larceny-theft offenses reported by Pennsylvania police agencies in 2013, an average of 539 each day, or one every 2 minutes and 40 seconds. This is a decrease of 3.7 percent from the 204,466 offenses reported the previous year. Larceny-theft comprised 64.1 percent of the Crime Index and 74.5 percent of the Property Crime Index. The larceny-theft rate was 1,541.3 per 100,000 population.
