

Analysis of Property Stolen

As outlined in the previous tables, \$148,150,548 in property was stolen in the 187,918 larceny-thefts reported in 2014, with an average value per larceny-theft of \$788. This is a decrease of 26.5 percent from the \$201,533,053 in property stolen in larceny-thefts the previous year. Purse Snatching showed the largest percentage increase in total dollars stolen, at 91.9 percent.
