

Arrests by Offense Category

In 2014, 59.9 percent of all Part II arrests were made in just four offense categories. These offenses were All Other Offenses (Except Traffic), 62,169 or 19.0 percent, with an arrest rate of 486.2; Driving Under the Influence, 47,908 or 14.6 percent, with an arrest rate of 374.7; Other Assaults - Not Aggravated, 43,837 or 13.4 percent, with an arrest rate of 342.8; and Disorderly Conduct, 42,201 or 12.9 percent, with an arrest rate of 330. The noted arrest rates are per 100,000 population.

Although "Curfew and Loitering Laws (under 18)" and "Runaways" are included in the calculations of Part II totals in the tables, they are not included in the calculations of the following summary information.

Arrests by Age

The distribution of Part II arrests by broad age categories was as follows: juveniles (under 18 years of age), 33,105 or 10.1 percent; young adults (18-24 years of age), 93,753 or 28.6 percent; and adults (persons 25 years of age or older), 200,547 or 61.3 percent.

Juvenile Part II arrests decreased 6.6 percent from the previous year's total of 35,452, while young adult Part II arrests decreased 6.5 percent from the previous year's total of 100,229, and Part II arrests of adults increased 1.0 percent from the previous year's total of 198,634.

Juveniles accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Vandalism (25.8 percent)
- Weapons, Carrying, Possession, etc. (23 percent)
- Liquor Law (22.7 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (21.6 percent)

Young adults (18-24 years of age) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Liquor Law (73.3 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (49 percent)
- Drug Sale/Manufacturing - Marijuana (41.9 percent)
- Stolen Property, Recovered, Possession, Buying (35.8 percent)
- Drug Sale/Manufacture - Opium - Cocaine (33.8 percent)

Adults (25 years of age or older) accounted for substantial proportions of arrests for the following Part II offenses:

- Gambling - Numbers, etc. (100 percent)
- Gambling - Book Making (90 percent)
- Prostitution and Commercialized Vice (83.2 percent)
- Gambling - Other (79.5 percent)
- Offenses Against Family and Children (77.8 percent)
- Fraud (76.1 percent)

The majority of young adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (14.6 percent)
Liquor Law (12.3 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (12.1 percent)

The majority of adult Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (21.2 percent)
Driving Under the Influence (18.2 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.2 percent)

Arrests by Sex

In 2014, 245,826 or 75.1 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were male, a decrease of 2.3 percent from the previous year's total of 251,674. Female arrests totaled 81,579, a 1.3 decrease from the previous year's total of 82,641.

The majority of male Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (19.7 percent)
Driving Under the Influence (14.7 percent)
Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (12.9 percent)
Disorderly Conduct (11.8 percent)

The majority of female Part II arrests were made for the following offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (16.8 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (16.1 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (14.8 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (14.5 percent)

Arrests by Race

In 2014, 229,327 or 70 percent of the persons arrested for Part II offenses were White, 95,292 or 29.1 percent were Black, and 2,762 or .8 percent were Other Races

Part II arrests of Whites decreased 3.1 percent from the previous year's total of 236,770 while Part II arrests of Blacks increased .5 percent from the previous year's total of 94,787. Part II arrests of Other Races increased .8 percent from the previous year's total of 2,740.

The majority of Whites were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- Driving Under the Influence (17.5 percent)
- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (15.9 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.4 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (12.7 percent)
- Drunkenness (8.3 percent)

The majority of Blacks were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (26.5 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (13.5 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (13.5 percent)
- Drug Possession - Marijuana (7.9 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (7.6 percent)

The majority of Other Races were arrested for the following Part II offenses:

- All Other Offenses (Except Traffic) (21.1 percent)
- Driving Under the Influence (19.0 percent)
- Disorderly Conduct (10.4 percent)
- Other Assaults - Not Aggravated (9.6 percent)
- Liquor Law (8.3 percent)
