

Summary

There were 13,534 robbery offenses reported by Pennsylvania police agencies in 2014, an average of 37 each day, or one every 38 minutes and 50 seconds. This is a decrease of 8.1 percent from the 14,725 offenses reported the previous year. Robbery offenses comprised 4.7 percent of the Crime Index and 33.6 percent of the Violent Crime Index. The robbery rate was 105.8 per 100,000 population.
