

Summary

There were 187,918 larceny-theft offenses reported by Pennsylvania police agencies in 2014, an average of 515 each day, or one every 2 minutes and 48 seconds. This is a decrease of 4.7 percent from the 197,191 offenses reported the previous year. Larceny-theft comprised 65.1 percent of the Crime Index and 75.6 percent of the Property Crime Index. The larceny-theft rate was 1,469.6 per 100,000 population.
